## Flowchart for managing cases of Covid-19 at Smith's Wood Primary Academy

If your child develops Covid-19 symptoms  or  If your child tests positive on a lateral flow test	If a family member from the same household tests positive for Covid-19 (lateral flow or PCR)	If your child or a family member is identified as a close contact by Track and Trace
<ul> <li>Inform the school</li> <li>Do not send your child to school</li> <li>Access a PCR test</li> <li>The child should isolate whilst awaiting the result</li> <li>Inform the school of the result</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Inform the school</li> <li>School will request that any children who attend school from this household access a PCR test</li> <li>The child should isolate whilst awaiting the result</li> <li>Inform the school of the result</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>NHS advice is for close contacts, as identified by Track and Trace, to access a PCR test</li> <li>The child can continue to attend school whilst awaiting the result</li> <li>If a PCR test is taken, inform the school of the result</li> </ul>







## If the result for the child is negative...

Your child can return to school

## If the result for the child is positive...

- Your child must self-isolate for 10 days
- You will be contacted by Track and Trace to identify close contacts
- School will no longer be expected to close bubbles for a single confirmed case
- Remote learning will be provided, should your child be well enough to complete this
