

- WHOLE SCHOOL ATTENDANCE IS 95.1\%
- 25 DAYS OF TERM LEFT
- STILL TIME TO IMPROVE
- REWARDS FOR PUPILS WITH GOOD OR IMPROVED ATTENDANCE

As we enter the last 5 weeks of term, whole school attendance at $95.1 \%$ is some way below the national average of $96.1 \%$. We also have too many pupils who are Persistently Absent (which means they have an attendance level below $90 \%$ ).

Staff have been asked to come up with additional ideas to improve attendance in each year group. There will be a number of reward events, in different year groups towards the end of term. The purpose is to reward good attendance and provide an incentive for those with low attendance to improve.

To access these events children must have either:

- A reasonable level of attendance for the school year ( $95 \%$ attendance since September)
Or
- Improved attendance in the final 5 weeks of term ( $95 \%$ during the last 5 weeks).

In this way, every child has an opportunity to be involved. Note that for those aiming to access the reward via the improved attendance route, each day of the 5 week period represents about $4 \%$, meaning only one day could be missed.
