- **Keep the aisles clear at all times.**
- Turn phones and tablets to silent
- Do not stand up in front of other spectators to film.
- At the end of each performance, children will remain in school until the usual time.
- Children who are off school ill, on a part time timetable or who are excluded from other schools are not permitted in the audience.
- Visitors requiring mobility access are requested to inform the office in advance.
- No prams or pushchairs are permitted in the hall during performances. (R-6)
- Please note that LED lights may be in use.
