- ✧ Sleep

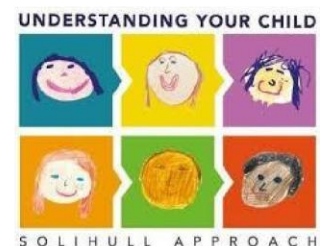
