Dear Parent/Carer

Next half term, Nursery's topic will be around 'working animals', where they will learn about all the different kinds of 'jobs' animals do and how they help us on a daily basis. This links to the understanding the world area of the EYFS curriculum. To consolidate their learning, we are offering all children the opportunity to experience an exciting day out to Ash End House Farm on Thursday 11th July 2024.

As part of the trip, children will be able to have; a guided tour of the farm, feed baby lambs, collect an egg from the chicks and also spend time enjoying the grounds.

The cost of the trip is £11.50, which includes entrance and the cost of petrol for the minibuses. This MUST be paid by Thursday 4th July. This is a voluntary contribution, however if not enough voluntary contributions are received then the trip will be cancelled. If for any reason you cannot pay by this date, please make an appointment with a Senior member of staff to discuss the option for a later payment to be agreed.

Children will need to be in Nursery at the normal time of 8.30am and will return to the school for collection at 2.45pm. Please collect your child from the main school building, as opposed the nursery building, access to this is through the carpark and we will release the children from the small hall to their named adult. We are aware the day will be longer than the children are used to; however, we feel it would be beneficial for the children in light of their upcoming transition into Reception. Please be advised that there will be no normal nursery session this day, as all nursery members of staff will be supervising children on the trip. We hope that all children will visit Ash End House Farm, however, if you do not wish your child to go, you will need to make alternative arrangements for your child on Thursday 11th July.

For the trip, children will need a packed lunch and a drink in a named lunch bag or small bag. A snack of fruit and milk will also be provided.

Children will need to wear school uniform, but comfortable shoes, such as trainers, will be permitted for the trip (no open toed sandals please). If you would like your child to visit Ash End House Farm with us, please fill out the slip on the ParentPay letter sent home & return as soon as possible.
