### Educational Visit: All Things Wild – Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> December

Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of our commitment to enhancing learning opportunities and providing high quality opportunities for all pupils at Smith's Wood Primary Academy, we are able to offer an educational visit to pupils in Year 3.

As part of our topic, Jurassic Park, we are going to 'All Things Wild' to take part in a number of different dinosaur activities.

Throughout the day, your child will go on a trip on a Dino Train to look at life-size dinosaurs, walk around the Dino Museum, which includes a timeline of events up until the extinction, and experience what life was like as a palaeontologist. As well as these activities led by 'All Things Wild' experts, we will also have our own time to explore the Dino Field as a class.

The trip will take place on **Wednesday 3rd December** and we are requesting a voluntary contribution of **£16.00 per child**, payable via ParentPay. This cost includes transport, entrance to the venue and all activities. This must be paid by 19th November 2025. If for any reason you cannot pay by this date, please make an appointment with a Senior Leader in school to discuss.

**It is important that your child arrives at 8:45am as we will be leaving promptly at 9:00am.** We are aiming to return to school for 3:10pm and will be travelling by coach. No parent or carer will be permitted to board the coach unless a member of staff requests that they do so.

Pupils will be required to wear full school uniform for this excursion. If it is a wet day, please ensure that your child has appropriate footwear (wellington boots are recommended) and a warm jacket (waterproof is recommended).

Your child will need a packed lunch for this visit, **if your child is eligible free school meals and you wish school to provide a packed lunch, please indicate this on ParentPay at the consent section.** Alternatively, you should ensure your child arrives with lunch and refreshments for the duration of the trip.

Any pupil that does not conform to school regulations or shows inappropriate behaviour may be taken off the trip. In this case full refunds will be given.
