Educational Visit: Silverstone Museum – Wednesday 19th November

Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of our commitment to enhancing learning opportunities and providing high quality opportunities for all pupils at Smith's Wood Primary Academy, we are able to offer an educational visit to all pupils in Year 2.

In Topic, Year 2 will be looking at different types of transport and the designs behind them. Therefore, we will be visiting **The Silverstone Museum**, where it offers an excellent opportunity for the children to develop their learning on modes of transport.

The trip will take place on **Wednesday 19th November** and we are requesting a voluntary contribution of **£19.95 per child**, payable via ParentPay. This cost includes transport, entrance to the venue and all activities. This must be paid by Wednesday 5th November 2025. This is a voluntary contribution, however if not enough contributions are received then the trip will be cancelled. If for any reason you cannot pay by this date, please make an appointment with a Senior Leader in school to discuss.

Pupils should arrive to school for **8:15am**, ready for departure at 8:30am. We are aiming to return to school for 3:00pm and will be travelling by coach. No parent or carer will be permitted to board the coach, unless a member of staff requests that they do so.

Pupils will be required to wear full school uniform for this excursion but are permitted to alter their footwear to trainers should they wish.

Your child will need a packed lunch for this visit, if your child receives universal free school meals or is eligible for free school meals and you wish school to provide a packed lunch please indicate this on ParentPay at the consent section. Alternatively, you should ensure your child arrives with lunch and refreshments for the duration of the trip.

Any pupil that does not conform to school regulations or shows inappropriate behaviour may be taken off the trip. In this case full refunds will be given.
